Thank you for the opportunity to make a submission to the above plan.

We farm in the Kaikoura Suburban and have concerns about the Red Zone status of this district.

The map indicating the Nutrient Allocation Zones shows Kaikoura in the Red Zone from the north side of the Kowhai River across the face of the Seaward Kaikoura Range to the Hapuku River. The map also highlights Lakes Rotoiti and Rotorua, one of these lakes has an extremely poor water composition and the map has not shown any red zone around these lakes which are on the south side of the Kowhai River.

The spring fed streams including the Lyell and Middle Creek are in the red zone and not the two Lakes. Having been on the Kaikoura Streamcare Group I understand the red zone status for Kaikoura is because of aged reports.

I would welcome collaboration and science being applied to the Kaikoura water status which is a different area from the Canterbury Plains, I am opposing one size fits all.
