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

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CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING SIGNIFICANT INDIGENOUS VEGETATION AND SIGNIFICANT HABITAT OF INDIGENOUS BIODIVERSITY

Schedule. Item.

# Representativeness

- Indigenous vegetation or habitat of indigenous fauna that is representative, typical or characteristic of the natural diversity of the relevant ecological district.
- Indigenous vegetation or habitat of indigenous fauna that is a relatively large example of its type within the relevant ecological district.
- Indigenous vegetation or habitat of indigenous fauna that is degraded but retains key natural ecosystem functions (for example hydrology or soil formation processes).

### Rarity/Distinctiveness

- 4. Indigenous vegetation or habitat of indigenous fauna that has been reduced to less than 20% of its former extent in the Region, or relevant land environment, ecological district, or freshwater environment.
- Indigenous vegetation or habitat of indigenous fauna that supports an indigenous species that is threatened, at risk, or uncommon, nationally or within the relevant ecological district.
- 6. The site contains indigenous vegetation or an indigenous species at its distribution limit within Canterbury Region or nationally.
- 7. Indigenous vegetation or an association of indigenous species that is distinctive, of restricted occurrence, occurs within an originally rare ecosystem, or has developed as a result of an unusual environmental factor or combinations of factors.

# Diversity and Pattern

8. Indigenous vegetation or habitat of indigenous fauna that contains a high diversity of indigenous ecosystem or habitat types, indigenous species, or genotypes, or has changes in species composition reflecting the existence of diverse natural features or ecological gradients.

#### **Naturalness**

 Indigenous vegetation that is in a relatively intact state for the relevant ecological district, i.e. has relatively little human modification.

## **Ecological Context**

- 10. Vegetation or habitat of indigenous fauna that provides or contributes to an important ecological linkage or network, or provides an important buffering function.
- A wetland which plays an important hydrological, biological or ecological role in the natural functioning of a river or coastal system.
- 12. Indigenous vegetation or habitat of indigenous fauna that provides important habitat (including refuges from predation, or key habitat for feeding, breeding, or resting) for indigenous species, either seasonally or permanently.
