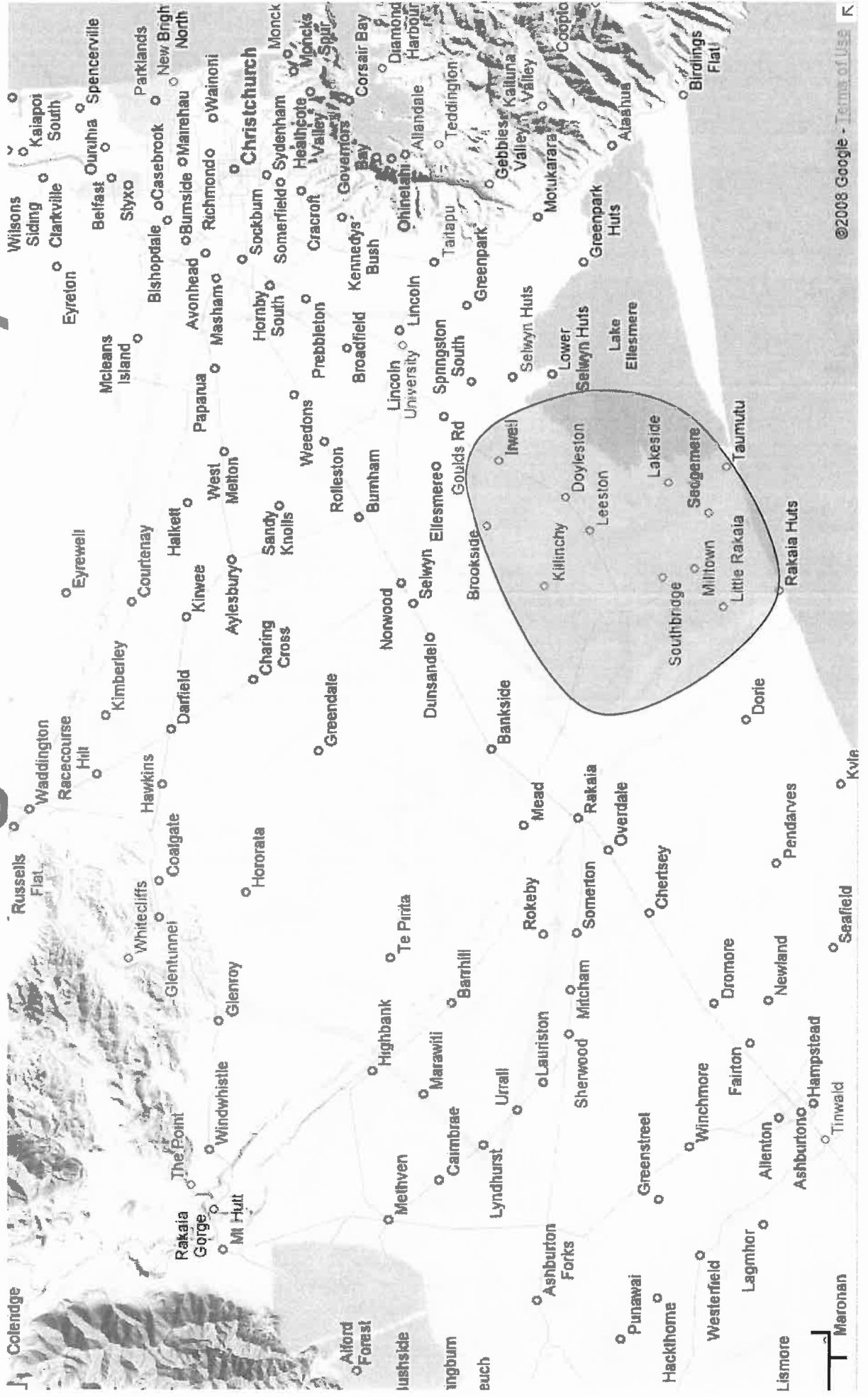

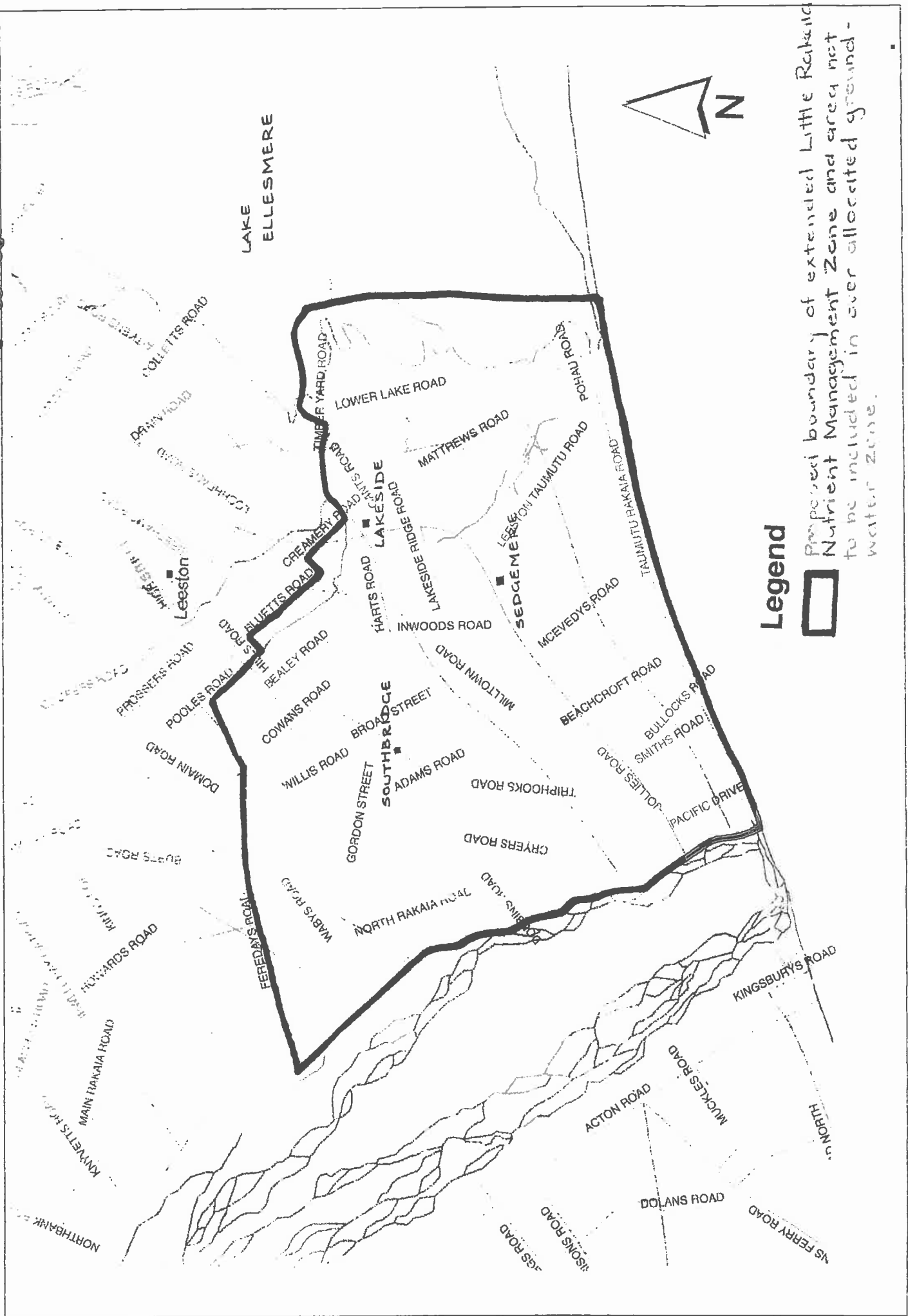

It does not require large quantities of water to be used almost all year round on high draining soils.
