## Notes to NZAAA Presentation to ECAN Re LWP

- 1) NZAAA SUPPORTS the following recommendation for aerial application of agrichemicals:
- 5.25 (Page 13) Where the discharge is from an aircraft:
  - (a) the discharge is be carried out by a person who holds a GROWSAFE® Pilots'
    Agrichemical Rating Certificate and an aerial application organisation that is
    AIRCARE™ Accredited
- 2) NZAAA SUBMITS that in respect of aerial application of VTA:
- 5.23 The same clause above should be added
- 3) NZAAA Submits that in respect of aerial application of fertiliser:
- 5.53 The Report currently recommends:
- 3. The discharge is be carried out by a person who holds a GROWSAFE® Pilots' Agrichemical Rating Certificate or an organisation that holds an AIRCARETM Accreditation

This should be changed to read:

The discharge is be carried out by an organisation that is AIRCARE™ Accredited

Note that NZAAA agrees with the Groundspread organisation that a GROWSAFE® Pilot's Agrichemical Rating is not required for the aerial application of fertiliser. Note too that the AIRCARE™ Programme requires that accredited companies use only Spreadmark Certified equipment.
