I have checked my records to determine the source of the tiered approach to mitigation proposed for the Horizons One Plan. I can confirm that the tiered mitigation approach was put forward by Mr Gerard Willis (independent planning consultant) on behalf of Fonterra to the Environment Court hearings. In particular Mr Willis sought a new definition identifying the tiers and the mitigation proposed; and incorporation of references to the tiers incorporated into the relevant rule conditions.

However, I can also confirm that this approach was not endorsed by the Environment Court in its interim Decision (which has been appealed on a point of law), and therefore has not been incorporated into the Horizons One Plan through the Environment Court Decision.

From this perspective, while an interesting proposition, the approach has not be endorsed or adopted into the One Plan at this stage, and therefore is no longer promoted to the Commissioners by the Hurunui Water Project.
