At the time the consent was granted the submitter complied with all aspects of the RMA. The LWRP decision took into account the submissions of the dairy industry and provided protection to dairy investment made during the baseline period that was made on the basis of having all necessary permits. The 2009-2012 baseline penalises the submitter because only the last 2 years of the baseline represent irrigated nutrient losses, setting the baseline over the 2009-12 period average loss will adversely affect the submitter's viability.</p>	<p>Add an amended definition of nitrogen baseline so that the figure is the maximum nitrogen loss over the 2009 to 2013 period.</p>
