My reason(s) for supporting, opposing or requesting amendments to this specific provision are:

I support this because it is the first necessary step to firstly preserving and then restoring the condition of Te Waihora and the waterways of the Lake catchment.

1. I would like to see the amendment regarding riparian fencing to be more explicit than 'effective' (the Variation changes the wording from 10m to 'effective'. 2m might be effective for sedimentation, but is useless for N and P. And 2m would still be useless for sedimentation if the waterway margins are sprayed clear of weeds. I think guidelines would be a good idea for different soil types and margin plantings.

Please give precise details for each provision. The more specific you can be the easier it will be for the Council to understand the outcome you are seeking.

I seek the following decisions from Environment Canterbury:

That Variation 1 be adopted with explicit reference to what 'effective' riparian strips must deliver in terms of sedimentation, N and P (and stock), and that guidelines for margin width be given for various soil types and plantings.
