My reason(s) for supporting, opposing or requesting amendments to this specific provision are:

The LSHOA broadly supports policy that promotes and protects the beauty and quality of the Te Waihora Lake Ellesmere ecology and environment.

We represent 54 hut owners at the Lower Selwyn Huts. While we currently lease a Right to Occupy from DOC, our community was surveyed for recreational use in 1894 and has been administered by several different agencies since then.

Many families with huts have been coming out to the river mouth for three or even four generations. Many of the huts still have wheels attached from when they started out as wagons that were pulled out to the reserve behind traction engines or horses.

We note that our community falls within the Te Waihora Cultural and Land Values Management Area around the margin of the Lake.

We would be very disappointed if this was used to force changes on our community as we already remove all our grey water and sewerage, and our leases with DOC stipulate only native plantings and maximum floor area for each hut. We take community water from an artisian well.

We represent 120 years of colonial recreation at the lake. Hunting, fishing, boating and relaxing by Canterbury families.
