This is a further submission in support of a submission on the following variation to a proposed plan:

Variation No 1 to the proposed Land and Water Regional Plan (Selwyn -Waihora).

I am a person who has an interest in the proposal that is greater than the interest of the general public. I am a landholder in the catchment area covered by the plan and my farm will be directly affected by the provisions for managing water quality and/or water quantity in the variation.

I support the entire submission of the North Canterbury Province of Federated Farmers of New Zealand.

The reasons for my support are:

- The proposals are pragmatic, linked to the outputs of the zone committee and consistent with my own views.
- The lack of consistency in approach, bias in the formulation of rules and the lack of any obvious attempt to relate those rules to desired outcomes is well documented in the submission.
- I particularly abhor the imposition of yet to be agreed standards and limits on current and future activities. We must work with what we know now and adopt an approach that does not preclude the integration of outputs from planned activities in this area (water quality).

I seek that the whole of the submission be allowed.
