I am a farmer/landholder in the catchment area covered by the plan and my farming activities/farm will be directly affected by the provisions for managing water quality and/or water quantity in the variation.

I support the entire submission of the North Canterbury Province of Federated Farmers of New Zealand.

The reason for my support is:

I support the reasons for the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan but it will have a huge effect on the way I can farm my property, both practically and financially. Like all consents that I have dealt with of late the documents are often vague and lacking in scientific evidence making them difficult



to comprehend and implement. Some of the measures within this document will severely limit the price of some land types sold and make it difficult to find a buyer. There will also be a great restrictions on the type of farming practises able to be carried out on existing traditional type farms making them unviable. The submission I am supporting goes some way towards making the Plan more achievable in the practical sense. We need a plan but not one that forces good farmers from the land or that encourages one farm type at the demise of others. Canterbury's economy has a strong agricultural base and therefore this plan needs to be strong on practicality. A lot of hours have been spent by good people, representing all walks of life, in consultation over the formation of this plan and it disappoints me to see a lot of the suggestions ignored.

I seek that the whole of the submission be allowed.
