Proposed new policies 1.(a)	Oppose V1pLWRP-370	<p>The specific reference in the provisions sought to a TLI score of 4.8 is not supported.</p> <p>While improving water quality outcomes within the catchment is supported it is important that the policies within the Plan are achievable within realistic timeframes.</p>
Proposed new policies 2.(c)(iii)	Oppose V1pLWRP-370	The specification of 2019 in the policy should be amended to coincide with the end of the next Long Term Plan cycle for local government being 2025.
Proposed new policies 3(a)	Oppose in part V1pLWRP-370	Clarification is sought as to whether water races are considered as part of all waterways referenced in the new policy sought. There are situations where water races should be excluded.
Policy 11.4.20	Support in part V1pLWRP-399	The specific reference to there being no adverse effects upon availability and quality of drinking water supplies is supported. Recognition of this gives effect to the Regional Policy Statement for Canterbury.
Replacement Policy 5	Oppose in part V1pLWRP-401	The provision on in-stream damming is opposed in part in relation to where there may be any conflict between the outcomes sought by the submitter and the submission by the Council to rule 11.5.42. The Council sought to ensure that damming excluded: culverts, fords, and water intake structures

		for community and stock water supplies in relation to the Selwyn River.
Rules 9.5.11 Rule 5.128 Condition of a Restricted Discretionary Activity	Oppose V1pLWRP-422	The change sought is not supported in so far as it would apply to community water supplies. It is more appropriate this be provided for as a matter of discretion to be considered on a case-by-case basis rather than a condition.
New Rules 11.5	Oppose V1pLWRP-443, 444, 446, 447, 448	The inclusion of the new rules relating to the discharge of treated sewerage sludge, bio solids from either a community wastewater treatment system or a domestic on-site waste water treatment system are not supported. The current rules (as sought to be changed by submissions of the Council) are appropriate and implement the relevant objectives and policies. The NZ Standard is not appropriate to apply to community water supplies.
Rule 11.5.32	Oppose V1pLWRP-449	The submission is opposed as so far as it may conflict with the original submission of the Council to this rule. The outcomes sought by the Council in its original submissions are appropriate and will give effect to the objectives and policies of the Variation.
Rule 11.5.33	Oppose V1pLWRP-450	This submission is opposed as far as it seeks to replace conditions 4 and 5 and add a new matter for discretion. The changes not necessary in order to manage adverse effects on the environment.
Rule 11.5.37	Oppose V1pLWRP-454	The submission is not supported as it relates to community water supplies as the provision would not give effect to the Regional Policy Statement.
Rule 11.5.43	Oppose V1pLWRP-456	The submission is not supported. The current provisions are sufficient to appropriately manage adverse effects of any works undertaken by a local authority within drains in the catchment.

Definitions Drainage Management Plan	Oppose V1pLWRP-457v	Deleting and replacing the definition of a Drainage Management Plan and the introduction of Schedule X is not supported. The current provisions are sufficient to implement the objectives and policies and the changes sought are not necessary.
