I am a person who has an interest in the proposal that is greater than the interest the general public has. I am a farmer/landholder in the catchment area covered by the plan and my farming activities/farm will be directly affected by the provisions for managing water quality and/or water quantity in the variation.

I support the submission of the North Canterbury Province of Federated Farmers of New Zealand.

6. Stock Exclusion from the Hill and High Country

The entire submission; or _____

The reason for my support is:

The requirement to exclude stock from all surface water is unworkable on a high country property due to the very high cost and the very likely loss of ability to use land. It would be incredibly

expensive to fence off our waterways and would also exclude stock accessing water to drink. High country properties do not tend to have poor water quality resulting from stock access.

For most hill or high country farming situations our main resource management concerns are the adverse effects of the spread of plant and animal pests and soil erosion, not the effects of stock access to surface water.

I seek that the whole of the submission be allowed.
