- 2. Further Submission:
- 2.1 This is a further submission in support of, or opposition to, primary submissions on Variation 1 to the Proposed Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan (Selwyn-Waihora Catchment) (Variation).
- 2.2 ANZCO made further submissions on other primary submissions on the Variation dated 9 June 2014.
- 3. Status of Further Submitter:
- 3.1 ANZCO has an interest in the Variation that is greater than the interest the general public has because:
 - 3.1.1 ANZCO operates a processing plant in Kynvetts Road, Rakaia, which lies within the Selwyn-Waihora catchment. ANZCO's Rakaia plant process livestock on a year round basis.
 - 3.1.2 ANZCO holds resource consents to take and use water (including an associated bore permit) and to discharge wastewater and stormwater to land. A clean, secure supply of water and the ability to effectively dispose of wastewater generated through processing and wash down activities are essential to the plant's on-going operation.
 - 3.1.3 ANZCO is dependant on its suppliers. The livestock processing industry does not exist without farming and farming is reliant on the processing industry to turn livestock into a saleable product.
 - 3.1.4 For these reasons, ANZCO has an interest in not only the aspects of the Variation that relate to or affect industrial processing activities, but also those concerning farming activities.
