1 Introduction

3 Proposed NRRP Chapter 7: Wetlands

Provision:

Amendment 2.6, addition to Table WTL1 (page 10).

Submission:

The first sentence in the right hand column doesn't make sense, beyond the words *Pareora Catchment*. Should the sentence be amended, as follows: ...*Pareora Catchment, but not with for the classification of wetlands or other activities that may affect wetlands*? Are the words beyond *Pareora Catchment* needed at all? Wording consistent with that in amendments 2.4 and 2.5 would suffice.

Decision Sought:

Ensure that the sentence makes sense and that the Proposed Pareora Catchment Environmental Flow and Water Allocation Regional Plan prevails over the Proposed Natural Resources Regional Plan. Federated Farmers recommends an amendment, as follows: ...Pareora Catchment, but not with for the classification of wetlands or other activities that may affect wetlands. Therefore Chapter 7 applies within this area.
