- 2. I could not gain an advantage in trade competition through this submission.
- 3. The specific provisions of the proposal that my submission relates to the provisions set out in Annexure 1.
- 4. My submission is as set out in Annexure 1. The Taylors Drain Water users group was set up by thirteen irrigation abstractors who obtain water from Taylors Drain. For some of these farmers this abstraction is their only source of irrigation water. The formation of the Water Users Group formalises a historic agreement that saw the users roster water use so as to maintain the minimum flow in the Drain. The total combined take of the users is currently 574l/s. At the User Groups expense we have installed a fully automated measuring devise on the drain to further ensure the required minimum flow is maintained
- 5. I seek the following decision from the local authority:

 - b. Such alternative relief that has the same, or similar, effect as that suggested in this submission.
