I live on the Port hills road, opposite the container yards

On days where the wind gets up the air quality is terrible, so thick you can see it

The house, contents and anything outside gets covered in the thick dust constantly, my children suffer with asthma, and I get headaches and nasal cattargh far more often than need be, more noticeable on hot dry days with the wind. The tendency is also for the wind to come from the ocean inland, therefore the dust gets blown over to the residential areas

The photo attached only shows a tiny portion, taken on a very still day, Saturday, 28th Feb - during a week day when the container yard is in full swing, then entire area is like this

There is an area to the right with a drive from the container yard onto Chapmans Road which is not sealed and I notice billous clouds whenever the container trucks drive in and out

I am happy to take more photos for evidence if you need, however I think the survey should show the problem, hopefully
