In regard to the type of wood burning fires you will approve to be installed :, Be fair to all the citizens who need and want a wood fire to keep their home properly warm in winter by offering several affordable approved fires for people to install in their home or rental property. Wood burners heat old houses best and are the most affordable source to heat a whole house as recommended by the WHO etc. Poorer and modest income families tend to live in these older homes. We cannot afford the amount of electricity it would need to achieve the same heat outcomes using electric heat pumps etc, we don't have double glazing, most don't have full insulation and certainly not a bottomless wallet. The people who are able to build new homes have double glazing and full insulation, heating their home with heat pumps may be the best option for them, however in a democracy they too ought to have a choice of approved wood burner that you accept. Also, remember all that snow after the earthquakes, and no electricity available, for our family a wood fire made the difference.
