Whilst in principle it makes sense to improve over time, there are some issues which have had plenty of time to resolve and the causer of the pollution should be held to account immediately. The Gelita factory in Woolston is a prime example of this. It has been known for many years that the odour and emissions from the plant are unacceptable but no action has been taken to prosecute. To suggest that it would take a further 3 years to solve is totally untrue as a technical solution can be put in place within 12months and any socially and environmentally responsible organisation in other industries would be reacting much faster.

Similarly the coal fired CDHB boiler in the CBD and at Burwood are have been creating significant issues and like Gelita the CDHB needs to be held to account
