We live at the Clearwater Resort,where I am Chairman of the Clearwater Resort Owners Society. We are adjacent to farms(about 500m away), that "truck in" and spray pig effluent on their farms, which I believe is consented. On ocassions the odours are very nauseating. The farmers are not complying with the consents, as they spray in calm or nor westerly conditions. Records have been kept and complaints made to ECAN to no avail. A particularly bad event occured during the NZ Womens Open when International visitors were present. It was a total embarrassment. Some of our residents have had to close all doors and windows and are verging on being physically sick.

If farmers cant comply with consents the practice of transferring effluent from pig farms to residential areas should be halted
