"Dischargers to air are managed to maintain the amenity values of the receiving environment"

It is vital that the citizens of Christchurch are able to voice concerns re. air pollution

Consultation Point 5.8 states - -

that air quality expectations throughout the region differ etc.

I support Environment Canterbury stance  
Again consideration of varying factors influencing air contaminants must be transparent, and negotiable.

Consultation Point 4:1 Iwi Management

- Dischargers to air are managed to maintain the amenity values of the receiving environment.

- restricted discretionary activity etc. from the application of liquid a slurry animal effluent.

## Consultation Point 6.7

"where as a result of authorised land use change, land use activities within the neighbourhood of a discharge into air are significantly adversely affected by that discharge, it is anticipated that within a defined time frame the activity giving rise to the discharge will reduce effects or relocate"

It is vital that Environment Canterbury has the power to cancel some consents if the initial granted consent has fundamentally changed.

I live at 7 Kaikainui Lane and have found that the application of pig effluent is a severe nuisance problem.

The discharge of odour from the pig waste contaminates our air and adversely affects our enjoyment of our environment.

It is my understanding the farmer ~~is~~ located on Dickey's Ret Coutts Island is shipping in effluent from other piggeries.

I seek clarification of the farmers consent - is he able to spread unlimited amounts and do so when weather

conditions are unsuitable eg. raining or low level clouds?? Is intensive pig farming legislated for??
