Background/Summary

When the updated Ashburton District Council District Plan became operative on 25 August 2014 the designation of land owned by some residents of Racecourse Road Ashburton was changed from Rural A to Residential D. As a result, these residents are affected by the changes introduced in the Canterbury Air Regional Plan (the pCARP). The affected residents are aware of the need "to manage the human influences on air quality in Canterbury" (pCARP 1-1) but would like to continue their existing land management routines with regard to regular maintenance of trees and vegetation. "Burning of organic matter in rural areas is still practised, and in some instances is a crucial land management tool" (pCARP 1-3). These residents would like the plan to be amended in order for them to continue burning organic matter within stated limits.
