My reason(s) for supporting, opposing or requesting amendments to this specific provision are:

I found the Section 32 report both unclear and 'cluttered'. This is why I do not feel able to make comment on specific sections.

For example I could find no definition of testing or how this is conducted. Are there comparable statistics for illness/mortality connected with living in damp and cold houses?

Whilst Option 3 for domestic heating sounds reasonable the other options are no longer viable in the Christchurch area but obviously do relate to other areas in Canterbury.

I seek the following decisions from Environment Canterbury:

As a homeowner who currently has a log-burner, I wish to have a low-emission appliance in my house. The property has to be re-built as a result of earthquake damage. However this is not apparently permitted.

I consider that Environment Canterbury appear to be overly focused on domestic log-burners being virtually the sole reason for poor air quality. This could be the rationale for any reason being seized upon to prevent home owners installing low emission log-burners (that presumably are deemed suitable in other districts). I feel aggrieved that I cannot have a choice of domestic heating due to the edicts of Environment Canterbury.

I would like a choice and for Environment Canterbury to allow approved low-emission log-burners throughout Christchurch in houses having to be rebuilt.
