Hi Mike

Late submission from Primeport relating to the Hazards, Risk, Safety and Biosecurity Portfolio, specifically Programme 2 - Navigational and recreational boating safety. I have spoken with the port company with regards this matter and have summarised their comments and my proposed solution below.

Background: At present each port pays for all costs incurred by council related directly to their operations. This includes travel to and from the port. This disadvantages the distance ports, such as Kaikoura, Akaroa and Primeport Timaru as they are located further from the Harbourmasters Office than Lyttelton Port Company.

Submission: The submission by Primeport does not dispute or disagree with the proposals within the Draft LTP. They ask for an equitable system of covering the costs of travel whereby each port pays a part of the costs. If this occurs there will be no benefit or disadvantage to any port operator due to their location within the region.

Resolution Suggested: The Harbourmaster implements an internal process to allocate all travel costs to the 'port safety-general' budget, which is funded by all port operators, thereby allocating costs across all f port operators (Lyttelton 50%, Timaru 25%, Akaroa and Kaikoura 25%).

Can you forward this submission regarding Port Charges.

PrimePort Timaru currently pays for Harbourmaster time as used. This currently comes out of the fixed fee for the port. I would like to submit that travel time to/from Lyttelton/Timaru for Harbourmaster attending monthly meetings etc is recovered from the general port fund instead of Timaru port fund. It is considered unreasonable that Timaru should pay this travel portion due to the fact that both Harbourmasters are based in Lyttelton.
