The Clean Heat program started installing low-emitting burners in early 2003. The current proposed wording of rule 7.87 would result, for those properties less than 2.0ha, in low-emitting burners to begin to be replaced from early 2018. For thousands of households this means that they will need to replace their current woodburners within the next three to five years.

I believe this does not provide enough time for many households to build up the financial capacity to replace such burners. Many homeowners are struggling financially and are energy-poor. The presently proposed timeframe at rule 7.87 is too restrictive as it will result in significantly increased hardship for many.

Also, until recently the low-emission burners, that are now proposed to be shortly prohibited, were fully approved by Environment Canterbury. This is a significant change of position by Environment Canterbury and has not been well communicated to homeowners with low emission burners. For instance I have received no letter from Environment Canterbury highlighting this change. Given that

the proposed rule change will have such a significant financial impact on thousands of Christchurch households, I believe this lack of clear communication will limit the number of opposing submissions Environment Canterbury will receive on this rule. I believe many homeowners will be unaware that shortly their still relatively new burners will be prohited. Proper consultation would have seen a letter detailing information on the proposed Space Heating rules sent to all consent holders for low emission burners.
