There should be provisions put into the regulations which allows recreational fishermen, small businesses and recreational hunters the option of using a smoke house (which burns untreated wood and sawdust in a cabinet) even though it might put a small amount of smoke into the air.

If small businesses need to be regulated , the cost of registering to use a small individual smoke house should be kept as low as possible , and should not be as expensive as a large commercial enterprise $\frac{1}{2}$
