- That the definitions in any of Ecans Policy Statements must not conflict with those given in statute. In this case the WMA2008. Making it more difficult for Council to meet its requirements under that legislation.
- That Council can support the commercial sector in business initiatives that align with Councils own goals of working toward a zero waste economy, benefiting the community and the environment.
- That the definition of “waste” in these documents do not include materials that have previously been discarded from one process are no longer defined as waste where an alternative end use for that material has been found in another process that benefits the community and the environment. That these material’s should be defined as being “Diverted”, “Recovered” or “Re-used”.

That the definition of “waste facilities” and “waste disposal facilities” in these documents do not include sites that specifically handle “Diverted”, “Recovered” or “Re-used” materials as opposed to residual waste and where these materials are further used in a new process that diverts material from landfill or other form of final disposal that has no benefit to the community or the environment
