SUMMARY OF DECISIONS REQUESTED GUIDELINES

As with all regional and district plan reviews and plan changes, the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA) requires the council to prepare a report summarising all the decisions requested. The original submission should be referred to if you are seeking to make a further submission, or to fully understand the issues raised by a submitter.

Each submission has been given a unique number and is coded against the plan provision, as shown below.

Where a submitter wants the Council to confirm the proposed change to the LWRP in Plan Change 4 'retain' is identified as the decision requested. Where submissions seek to keep the operative LWRP provisions and reject the PC4 amendment, 'delete' is identified as the decision requested.

Where a submission requests amendments to the text, this has generally been identified with strikethrough for deleted text and underlining for inserted text. However, if amendments are not apparent, then the direction provided in the submission has been included. Submissions which quote substantial sections of the Plan Change 4 text without amendment, ellipses [...] have been included to indicate the omitted text.

Where the decision requested is unclear, this is stated, and the reader ought to refer to the original submission.

Many submissions included a request for 'any such consequential amendments' or similar. Such requests have not been included in the summary of decisions requested. The Hearings Panel will be able to consider consequential amendments during the course of the hearings.
