MAY IT PLEASE THE COMMISSIONERS:

- This Memorandum of Counsel responds to an email from the Planning Officer Hearings sent to Counsel for Central South Island Fish & Game ("CSI F&G") dated Saturday 12 December 2015.
- This email was sent attaching Commissioners Minute 5 (**"Minute"**) following expert caucusing. This Minute is dated 19 November 2015.
- The Minute directs that a Judicial Conference will be held on 15 December 2015 at 9.30am to attempt to narrow or eliminate any outstanding issues and better understand the remaining areas of disagreement between experts.
