How is it to be decided how much fertaliser a farm can put on. It is unfair to have it on a percentage of what fertisiles a farmer has applied in the past. If farmers are required to have a farm environment plan because of precieved poor water quality in rural areas shouldn't urban people have environment plans to stop polluntants from their businesses and life styles in the city where some of New Zealards most polluted water ways are. Every time it rains in Christchuch how much vechicle exhaust emissons and pollunants from

business yards and other work site premmises end up in the storm water which leads into the Avon, Heathcote and other rivers around these built up areas. It is not just farmers that are down grading water quality.

The whole water quality issue is losing crediability when the Government announces. That the acceptable level for waterways could be waderable and boating, no longer swimming. What sort of message does that send to people when E. Can is now run by Government

approved people.

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
