 - Ambient
 - Localised
 - Cumulative

Adverse effects of discharge into air on wahi tapu and wahi taonga and Sites of Significance are of concern to Ngai Tahu.

How does Rule 7.2 and the consent process ensure that TRoNT or Papatipu Runanga will be involved?

3. Rule 7.2

Taking the fifth paragraph on page 4-7 (headed Conclusion) of the pCARP as the starting point, were we to find that the deletion of specific reference to sites of significance from the permitted activity rules was inappropriate, could iwi management plans be a mechanism for identifying such sites? And if so, how could this be written into the pCARP and where should it be included?
