

PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED CANTERBURY LAND AND WATER REGIONAL PLAN - AMENDED AND RE-NOTIFIED SUMMARY OF DECISIONS REQUESTED

Pursuant to Clause 7 of the First Schedule of the Resource Management Act 1991, the Canterbury Regional Council (Environment Canterbury) gives notice that the Amended and Re-notified Summary of Decisions Requested by Submitters on the Proposed Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan is available for inspection.

A Summary of Decisions Requested by Submitters was made available for inspection on 31 October 2012. That original Summary contained a number of errors. The Amended and Re-notified Summary which is now available corrects the errors which were contained in the original Summary.

Copies of the Amended and Re-notified Summary of Decisions Requested and the original submissions are available for public inspection, at the offices of Environment Canterbury at:

Further Submissions

Further submissions in support of or opposition to the original submissions may now be made. A further submission must be limited to a matter in support of, or opposition to, a relevant original submission, and must be in the form which is prescribed as Form 6 in Schedule 1 of the Resource Management (Forms, Fees and Procedures) Regulations 2003. A further submission form is included in the Amended and Re-notified Summary of Decisions Requested or can be obtained from:

Under Clause 8 of the First Schedule to the Resource Management Act 1991, the following persons may make a further submission:

- Any person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest; and
- Any person that has an interest in the proposed plan greater than the interest that the general public has; and
- The local authority itself.

A copy of the further submission must be served on the person who made the original submission to which the further submission relates, within five working days of providing the further submission to Environment Canterbury.

Any further submissions which had already been made and received by Environment Canterbury by the time the Amended and Re-notified Summary of Decisions Requested had been notified will be carried forward and remain valid, provided that the person who made the further submission does not seek to amend or replace it. Any person who has already made a further submission may amend or replace that further submission within the time period specified in this notice.

The closing date for further submissions is Thursday 20 December 2012.
