## **MATTER:**

ALTERATION TO THE COUNCIL'S DECISIONS ON THE MATTER OF 'THE RECONSIDERATION OF THE ACTIVITY STATUS FOR WATER-RELATED ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH EXISTING HYDRO-ELECTRICITY GENERATION AND REGIONALLY SIGNIFICANT INFRASTRUCTURE AS CLASSIFIED BY THE LAND AND WATER REGIONAL PLAN'.

Clause 16(2) of Schedule 1 to the RMA states:

"A local authority may make an amendment, without using the process in this schedule, to its proposed policy statement or plan to alter any information, where such an alteration is of minor effect, or may correct any minor errors"

The following alterations of minor effect have been made to Rules 5.125C and 5.125D which form part of the Council's decisions on the matter of the 'reconsideration of the activity status for water-related activities associated with existing hydro-electricity generation and regionally significant infrastructure as classified by the Land and Water Regional Plan'.
