## Errata Plan Change 6 section 42A Report

Several minor errors have been identified in the section 42A report. The errors are set out below and have been corrected in the version of Plan Change 6 showing officer section 42A report recommendations.

### Recommendation - Section 10 Introduction

1. Page 13-7, Line 1: the struck through words "...is shown in..." should be deleted because the text did not form part of proposed Plan Change 6 as notified, and have been incorporated in the section 42A report recommendation in error. The first line should read:

*~~Figure 2 defines the extent of the Lake Forsyth / Wairewa catchment. The Lake Forsyth / Wairewa<sup>(1)</sup> catchment covers the land from mean high water springs at Birdlings Flat...~~*

2. Page 13-8, 2nd paragraph: underlining should extend to include the words "...game bird habitat." to show the text is part of the paragraph recommended to be inserted. The 2nd paragraph should read:

*Lake Forsyth/Te Roto o Wairewa and its tributaries, the Ōkana and Ōkuti rivers, are classed as a locally important salmonid fishery, and the Lake is also classed as nationally and regionally significant game bird habitat.<sup>(2)</sup>*

### Recommendation - R10.1

3. Page 13-9 paragraph [13.34]: "Regional Coastal Environment Plan 2005" should be underlined to indicate that it is an insertion. The recommendation should read:

#### ***10.1 Other Regional Plans that apply in the Banks Peninsula Sub-region***

*~~Nil-Regional Coastal Environment Plan 2005<sup>(3)</sup>~~*

### Recommendation - R10.4

4. Page 13-13 paragraph [13.66]: The recommendation should be amended to show the original 'Note' as notified, in strikethrough. The recommendation should read:

*~~No additional policies apply in the Banks Peninsula Sub-region, in addition to those set out in Section 4 of this Plan.~~*

*~~Note: No policies additional to those in Section 4 of this Plan apply in the Banks Peninsula Sub-region, except that the following policies also apply in the Lake Forsyth / Wairewa catchment.~~*

*~~Note: The following policies apply within the Lake Forsyth/Wairewa catchment in addition to those set out in Section 4 of this Plan.~~<sup>(4)</sup>*
