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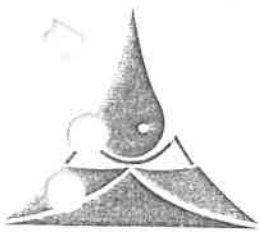

## YOUR APPLICATION FOR WATER RIGHT

In the absence of any appeal within the 28 day period mentioned, the decision granting the right is final and the attached right should be retained in your safekeeping.

The granting of the right does not absolve the grantee from obtaining the consent or approval of any authority whose consent or approval may be required in respect of any works associated with the implementation of the attached water right.

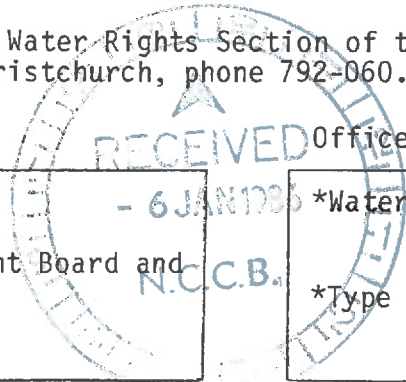
