Ravensdown supports the inclusion of Whiterock Quarry in the Site-led Programme for eradication of Wild Thyme.

We consider that the management of Wild Thyme on the quarry site and 3.5ha of land leased from the Milne family trust (Lot 4 DP755) to the north of the quarry fits with our existing maintenance regime for managing weeds and do not see it as an onerous addition. We will continue to work with Environment Canterbury to fulfil our obligations under the Regional Pest Management Strategy.

We request that Environment Canterbury retains inclusion of Wild Thyme management at Whiterock Quarry as a Site-led Programme as proposed.
