## Title

Appointment of Decision Maker to decide an objection to decision

## Purpose

To appoint a Hearing Commissioner to hear and decide an objection to decision to extend a lapse date for resource consent CRC156747 held by Omihinui Limited.

## Recommendations

*That the Committee, in regard to an objection to decision of resource consent CRC156747 – Omihinui Limited*

*(a) Appoints Robert Nixon as a Hearings Commissioner under s34A of the Resource Management Act 1991; and*

*(b) Delegates to Robert Nixon pursuant to s34A(1) Resource Management Act 1991, the function, powers and duties required to: deal with any preliminary matters; hear; and decide the objection to decision.*

## Proposal

### Background

Omihinui Limited applied to extend the lapse date of the consent. The objection is against the decision to decline the extension of the lapse date for a period of 6 months to expire 30 March 2018. The current consent lapsed on 30 September 2017.

### Discussion

The proposed commissioner, Robert Nixon, has satisfied Council staff he has the necessary criteria, including technical ability, RMA Accreditation certification, availability and timeframe commitments to carry out the duties required.
