Lower Cashmere Residents' Association

Louise Ayling and Shelley Johnson of the Lower Cashmere Residents' Association with Cashmere Community Board member Melanie Coker described their concerns regarding emissions from the Cashmere View Retirement Village, Rose Street, Christchurch.

An air monitoring report, dated 19 April 2016, prepared by New Zealand Air Quality Consultancy (NZAIR) for Bupa Care Services Limited (Bupa) provided by the Residents had been circulated to the Councillors.

Ms Ayling explained that the since the laundry was installed in 2011 odours have been experienced by the residential neighbours, particularly during spring and autumn and in northly and westerly wind conditions. The residents are concerned that they do not know what the odour actually is and what are they being exposed to.

The deputation made the following requests:

- 1. A third-party peer review of the NZAIR report for assurance of the methodology for assessing the effects on residential properties.
- 2. Is the current monitoring regime undertaken by Bupa enough?
- 3. Information on the earlier recommendations provided by Bupa to the Council to address odour issues and what recommendations are outstanding.

The Chair thanked the deputation for their presentation and advised that matters raised will be investigated and a reply made as soon as possible.

8. Outstanding Contribution Award – Charles Crofts

Charles Crofts and his whanau were welcomed to the meeting with a mihi by Cr Cranwell.

The Chair read the citation:

In recognition of the outstanding contribution that Charles Crofts has made to this Council as a Te Rūnanga o Koukourārata representative engaged in the Environment Canterbury Tuia partnership.

Charles Crofts has a long association with Environment Canterbury and its predecessor the North Canterbury Catchment Board. Charles was one of the early advisors to this Council at the time the Resource Management Act was enacted in 1991.

Charles was a founding member of the Selwyn/Waihora Water Zone committee, Te Paiherenga and Te Rōpū Tuia. He was Co-Chair of Te Rōpū Tuia with Dame Margaret Bazley and he currently Co-Chairs with myself.

Charles Crofts champions Ngāi Tahu values and has gained absolute respect from fellow Canterbury water Management Strategy committee members, Mayors, Environment Canterbury Councillors, farmers, environmentalists, and all others. His leadership has been critical to the success of the CWMS.

His commitment to natural resource management pre-dates the CWMS, in particular his unwavering obligation to the Ngāi Tahu Settlement with the Crown.

Charles was in the Ngāi Tahu 'A Team' for negations with the Crown. He was responsible for negotiating directly with Ministers and resolving any major differences. The A Team used the Nine Tall Trees as their evidence for the Claim. The Ninth Tall Tree was mahinga kai. Mahinga kai is now a principle focus for the CWMS work programme.

So a sincere thank you Charles, for your life-long work to sustain the health of the land, rivers, lakes, harbours and coastline of Waitaha/Canterbury. This Council truly appreciates the positive and influential leadership you provide to our staff and to the wider community.
