I can understand if you reduce the times to peak hours for theses services like you have done for the 95 Waikuku.

I feel it is important to not raise the fares for the next three years as this will then incourage others to use the services and to get long standing habbits in place before people are put off by a fare increase.

## In Short:

- 1 Re look at the 6 routes and potetialy cut down to a peak service only. (feeds into other services)
- 2 Do not increase fares for a minimum of 3 years (to promote cheap travel)
- Do a targeted rates rise. (this may indrectly encourage rate payers to use the service so they can get use of the rates dollars)
