As a non driver, I am very concerned about the proposed discontinuation of the 150 route. While the current service appears to be catering mainly to school services - it is definitely not of use to anyone who needs to bus to work, a twenty minute walk from Burwood Hospital after a day at work is not attractive at all - it is better than no bus service at all as it was until September.

I would actually like to see the service expanded, there must be two or three thousand people living in the Prestons subdivision (which is continuing to grow) who need access to public transport. There are also businesses opening in the area, how will people get to the new supermarket?

I heard of a proposal to extend the route that currently serves the Redwood area, that would definitely be worth looking into as an option, the residents in our area need a seven day a week bus service.
