I appreciate the need to stop operating the 535 route given its lack of use, but please, please, please relax the rules regarding the carriage of bicycles inside the No. 28 bus, as without the 535, many of us early morning cyclists will fail to get to work on time. The relaxation only need to be between the hours of 6:30 and 7:30, so that the several cyclists (often 4 or 5) that rely on both the 28 and 535 at 6:40am (following the 6:30 ferry) to get through the tunnel can still get through the tunnel and make it to work on time. At this time of day there are never passengers with pushchairs or wheelchairs, and the spaces on the bus for these items stands empty. Please relax these rules and allow bicycles on the 28 early in the morning.
