Discontinuation of bus route in Westmorland is a poor and lazy option.

There are plenty of changes that could be made to this route to make it more appealing and less costly.

Putting the small buses on at School times while having the large buses used at off peak times is crazv.

The morning route times don't work well for Chch South school and should be 10 minutes earlier to bring this cohort into use.

The Westmorland route should be looping round Penruddock and Ravensdale as this suburb is growing due to councils encouraging this. Having a whole suburb without a bus route is negligent by ECAN as manager of this.

I would suggest using small buses all the time and have more buses on at school times (quarter hourly) and fewer during the rest of the day (hourly).
