To facilitate sustainable development of a local region transport service for the longer term and to make the best use of resources Environment Canterbury should:

- 1. Approve the establishment of a people commuter rail link service between Rangiora and Rolleston via Christchurch city using the existing railway.
- 2. Integrate the commuter rail link service with the city bus system thus creating higher bus patronage numbers.
- 3. Meet the cost of a commuter rail link service by ceasing expenditure on planned four-lane road highways and on widening bridges leading in

to Christchurch and by freeing up, for disposal, land allocated for car parking in the Central Business District.
