I am objecting to the plan to cancel the 107 bus route out to Styx Mill. This is the ONLY public transport to Willowbank and Styx Mill reserve. Willowbank is a major tourist attraction and tourists often do not have cars. I cannot imagine Wellington City cutting all public transport to the Wellington Museum, can you?

In addition, families with young children do not always have second vehicles. Essentially, you are cutting off a major recreational area to anyone who doesn't drive.

Rather than cutting the route, why not extend the 108 route so it covers this area or approach Willowbank to partially fund the route?

The bus stop outside Willowbank is a visible reminder that plenty of people DO use this route. It is decorated with thousands of Willowbank day pass arm bands. as it has become a tradition for visitors to stick them on there when they leave via bus.

I really cannot imagine any other major city in New Zealand considering getting rid of all public transport to one of its top 10 attractions. You need to understand that the constant changes and poor layout of routes is why our bus system is hemorrhaging customers. There should be a direct route to Willowbank and Styx Mill Reserve from the exchange, not one where people have to switch sometimes three times just to get there. But having no bus at all is ridiculous.
