Instead of discontinuing the lowest performing routes, these need to be reviewed as to why they are low performing. As a resident of Westmorland, the 145 route no longer goes where we want to and now requires at least one change of bus to get into town. It is at least an hour to get into town on a good day, often longer.

The bus is very well used by Cashmere High students heading from Westmorland to school in the mornings and again in the afternoons.

One suggestion would be to extend the blue line to include Westmorland. This extension could operate intermittently to align with school and work hours.
