My autistic son would be catching this next year from Styx mill country club. A 5 min walk from our home then dropped outside Papanui High. This teaches him independence etc. if cut would need to walk over 25 mins (not possible for him). Then walk another 10 at the end of ride. Not acceptable and would mean changing work times to get him to school. How is this improving independence/ safety etc. today alone st 7.59 I went past Styx mill country club stop and there were 9 school pupils from various schools standing at the stop plus 2 elderly and 1 middle aged man. This occurs every morning at this time. Even time to suit school pick up drop offs at both ends be effective and save money.
