I suggest there needs to be a service to all 6 locations in the following way.

Combine the 106 and the 107 routes and leave the other 4 routes in thier current route. But the now 5 routes have a service leave thier respective hubs at around 8.30ish then go to their destiations and return to thier hubs. And the same be repeated in the afternoon around 3.30ish.

So a total of 2 return trips a day spending around 5 or 6 hours at the location ttey have traveled from the hub to or if catching the bus on the return trip to the hub, 4 or 5 hours to connect to another service and get back to the hub for the afternoon return trip.
