Purpose

1. To appoint a Hearing Commissioners to hear and decide resource consent application CRC182004 to be held by Longland Dairies Limited.

Recommendations

That the Regulation Hearing Committee, in regard to resource consent application CRC182004 to be held by Longland Dairies Limited:

Background

2. Longland Dairies Limited have applied to change conditions of an existing consent to take groundwater to add a deep bore and remove a shallow bore. The existing seasonal volume will not be altered. The water will be used for stock water, dairy shed wash-down and the irrigation of 314 hectares of crops and pasture. There will be no change to the duration of the consent.
3. The application was limited notified to one party who has submitted in opposition and wishes to be heard.

Proposed Commissioners

4. Emma Christmas has satisfied Council staff she has the necessary criteria, including technical ability, RMA Accreditation certification, availability and timeframe commitments to carry out the duties required as a Hearing Commissioner

Legal compliance

5. S34A of the Resource Management Act 1991 allows Council to delegate functions to Hearing Commissioners appointed by the Canterbury Regional Council.
6. The Regulation Hearing Committee appoints Hearing Commissioners in relation to consent authority matters under the Resource Management Act 1991.
