We live on Westmorland. We are in our 70s. We may not be able to drive for much longer. We do use the bus occasionally to go to the hospital or into the city centre. If service 145 is withdrawn life will be very difficult for non-drivers to remain in Westmorland.

We understand that our daytime, evening and weekend buses are not well used. Our personal view is that we could manage with less frequent buses out of peak hours so perhaps an hourly extension to an existing route is possible? Maybe to the blue line. We suspect that if the 145 went directly to the city it would be better used. On that basis an extension to the blue line could well serve our needs.

There is no shop or medical centre within walking distance for elderly people, life really would be difficult with no car and no bus.
