I do not believe enough emphasis has been placed on the purpose and community outcomes.

Too often do signs get erected to say no swimming in our Heathcote River. This I believe to be due to sewage overflow after rain events. I believe this system to be totally unacceptable and all stops should be made to update this water management system so that it no longer impacts on our rivers. The rivers are not to be used as sewers for Christchurch.

Please place a lot more emphasis on delivering actual outcomes rather than just advising / monitoring / reporting. We need this water system fixed so that our children can "play and swim in the rivers".

Please allocate more funding to delivering your stated outcomes.
