I fail to see how Options 1,2 and 3 can be called consultation when they all present discontinuing bus services as a "fait accompli". Our children use the 145 service to Westmorland from two different schools and even receive emails from Metrocard to say "each time you get on board with us, you're making a positive difference to our city - way to go".

Exploration of better routes and timetables to service the Westmorland suburb should be undertaken but leaving a slightly isolated and fast growing area with no bus service is not the solution.

If the 145 is discontinued can we expect a reduction to our rates? I think not.
